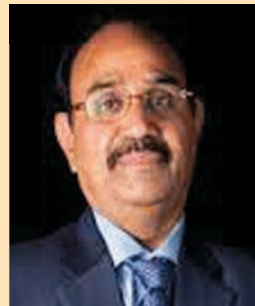

Report of the General Secretary

This is my second report as the General Secretary and I am grateful that this opportunity was given to me. During the past one year, whatever we have achieved was due to the participation of all members.

During the year 2016-17, we collected 3953 more One Teacher Schools (OTS) than the previous year, which is 24.39% more than the last year. As a result of this for the first time in the history of FTS, our total collection crossed 600 million rupees. This is a major achievement landmark and I congratulate all for this great achievement.



Number of Members

During this one year, membership of FTS has reached 3534 from . Although the number of members has increased, there is still scope of increasing membership in many chapters. I take this opportunity to request you all to pay adequate attention towards the collection of membership fees and increasing social participation by enrolling new members.

Donor Base

Our donor base is a concern. As on March 2017, this was limited to 3080 donors. Unless we increase the donor base our collections cannot increase much.

You are all aware that effective from April 01, 2017 we will not have the facility of exemption under section 35AC of Income Tax Act. During financial year of 2016-17 we collected record amount of donation under this section. I request you all to increase our donor base so that we have a larger base of donors that will offset the impact of the withdrawal of 35AC.

Supply of Shikshan Samagri

Supply of shikshan samagri to the schools has improved substantially. West Bengal, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan all have successfully completed their deliveries. In other states, the status is better than the last year, however further improvement is expected.

This performance of our chapters demonstrates that if we all try sincerely, there is no reason why we cannot supply materials within the month of March, 2018. I sincerely

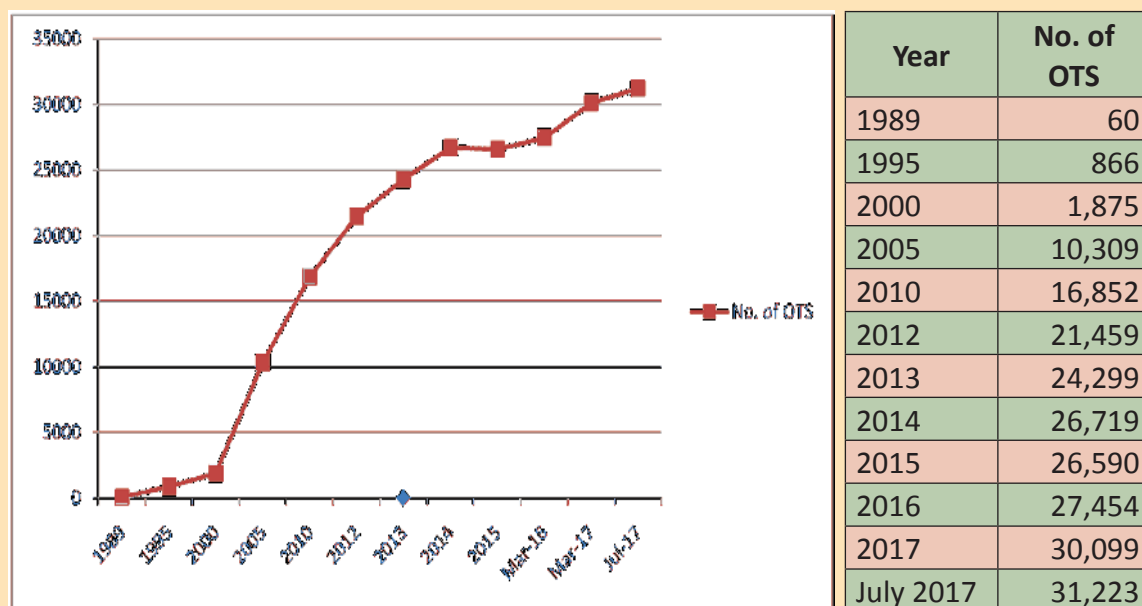
hope that all our OTS will receive all materials within March, 2018. If necessary let there be some changes in procurement and distribution policy, which will ensure timely supply of Shikshan Samagri.

Number of OTS

For the year 2017-18, our target for collection of OTS is 40,000. During last year the growth in collection of OTS during last year gave us hope that we would be able to collect the target set for the chapters. During the year 2016-17, an increase in collection of OTS was 3953 and we expect that all chapters would collectively achieve the target accepted by them.

Progress in achievement

There has been spectacular growth in the number of OTS opened in different states in the Country. Number of OTS, over a period of time, is given below:



These are the figures of schools funded and monitored by Friends of Tribals Society. In the year 2000, two more organizations namely Bharat Lok Shiksha Parishad and Ekal Vidyalaya Foundation of India started functioning. From the year 2011 a few State Voluntary Organizations came into being to concentrate on small donations collected from local area. All these organizations are funding and monitoring running of OTS and state-wise position as on March, 2016 is annexed below.

Accounts

I reported last year that there has been an improvement in the submission of accounts. However, in some chapters both quality of accounts and its submission in time need attention. I would take this opportunity to request you all to follow the manual of accounting system that has been sent to all chapters. Activities like selling tickets for programmes, roping sponsors are strictly prohibited in FTS. A circular was sent to all chapters mentioning therein the restrictions in cash receipt as well as cash payment in terms of proposal included in recent finance bill. We hope that the chapters are following the guidelines. The chapters were also sent circulars for issuance of OTS receipt in a systematic and standardized manner and I would take this opportunity to reiterate that this is very essential for proper maintenance of our accounts and database.

We are contemplating to link the accounts of National Office along with a few selected chapters so that we are in a position to know the accounting entries in those chapters.

Opening of New Chapters

In my last report I reported that two of our chapters, namely Pune and Rourkela were not functioning properly. I have the pleasure to inform you that a new Executive Committee has been formed in Pune and this new committee is expected to work efficiently.

A new chapter was inaugurated at Vadodara on June 20, 2017 under the presidency of Shri Tribhuvan Kabra. Another chapter is expected to be opened at Ahmedabad within this year. Initial discussion to open a chapter at Vijaywada has started. In all we have 33 chapters.

Vanyatra

You are aware that many of us joined FTS after attending the Vanyatra. It has the immense impact on those who undertook the journey and most of them either have become a member or a donor and some people even are acting as both. This year we have awarded chapters that have conducted seven or more Vanyatras. For the next year, we propose to increase the number of Vanyatra to ten for awarding the chapters. I would expect that when we will be awarding the chapters in the next Annual General Meeting, all the chapters would be eligible to get this award.

Training

All chapters must know by now about the impact of Saksham, a specialized training for our Sevabratis. As this training has been found to be very useful, the Central Executive

Committee in their meeting held on July 16, 2017 at Hyderabad has decided to start this type of training at few other centres namely Surat, Jaipur and Coimbatore; the training will follow the design that has been followed at the Kolkata centre. Till now 25 batches have passed out from Kolkata and total number of participants is 424.

Asha Kiran Project with Rotary Club

We reported you earlier that we are implementing one Project named Asha Kiran with the partnership of Rotary International. Although we were supposed to cover 15000 children under this project in West Bengal, Odisha and North-East states, we could cover only 12177 children, details of which are given below:

After submitting the profile of the children and their photographs, we submitted the monthly information system in respect of the children to the Rotary International. The teams of Rotary Club also visited some of the schools and they have submitted their report to us. We have discussed the report amongst us and we will soon meet the representatives of Rotary Club to take the project forward.

Mahila Samity

During the year 2016-2017, Rashtriya Mahila Samity conducted meetings at Kolkata, Agra, Indore and Mumbai. In all there was attendance of 256; 86 being the highest and 33 being the lowest. Zonal Meetings were held at Jaipur, Dhanbad, Surat and Rourkela. There are 38 Mahila Samities in the country. They conducted various activities, namely Sankranti Collection, Exhibition, Seva Patra Collection, Tree Plantation, Picnic, Vanyatra, Deepotsov, Health Check-up, Sanch Adoption, OTS Collection, Visit of Ekal Children to Cities, Drawing Competition etc.

FTS Pragya

A new platform named FTS Pragya has been launched on a pilot basis in Kolkata. About 50 eminent persons coming from different professions have associated themselves with FTS Pragya. It has been officially launched on May 2, 2016. We propose to launch FTS Pragya in some other chapters and we expect that the chapters will actively take interest

in the formation of such platform in their chapters.

Technology

Our Management Information System (MIS) project is running in full swing, all Monthly Accounts Report (MAR) and Monthly Works Report (MWR) are supposed to be uploaded every month on MIS platform.

Effective from April 2017, we have changed the technology and platform of MIS. The present system is browser and device independent and MIS can be accessed from any device. We are using Linux, MySQL, Apache and PHP for our MIS and all these are freely available without incurring cost. The new platform matches data collection and data entry as practiced in Ekal Abhiyan. The new platform is designed to integrate data analytics platform and exposes all data through API. This new platform will generate many reports which were not available earlier.

Branding of FTS

In the month of June 2015, the Governing Board decided that we had to work on the branding of FTS so that the awareness of our Organization gets spreaded. We have already worked with one brand consultant and soon we engaged a reputed agency to work on different aspects of branding. We also appointed a Public Relations firm to take care of our requirements. We have produced one documentary also.

As all such activities involve expenditure and we are new to this field, we implemented the project at Kolkata, Mumbai and Guwahati on pilot basis and the response was good.

Conclusion

The Friends of Tribals Society (FTS) is not an organization. It is a movement. We call it an "Abhiyan". FTS probably is the largest Organization where all members of different samities from village to National Office work voluntarily. As we all work voluntarily for the cause of our Mother Land, it is necessary that we all work with utmost dedication.

I wish you all a happy, prosperous, action-filled and target-achieving future.
